- Libraries are key partners, respected local institutions, and well-equipped to lead in this work.



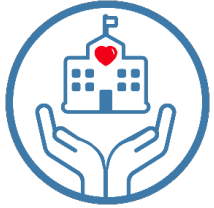

Supporting career and college connections.

Grant Purpose

- This grant opportunity will fund effective programs to support students in overcoming learning disruptions caused by the pandemic, ***with a focus on supporting literacy.***
- Programs that also prepare students for future success will receive preference, but it is not a requirement.
- Preparing students for future success is defined as college and career awareness and/or preparing students for their nearest transition, such as preschool to kindergarten or elementary to middle school.

Design Requirements

- Capacity and Readiness of Library System
- Student Needs
- Program Outcomes
- Project Timeline
- Budget

Eligible Applicants

- Ohio's public library systems are eligible to apply
- Collaboration is permitted but one system must serve as the fiscal agent
- To receive a grant, applicants must have a valid UEI and SAM registration
- Applicants need to acquire an IRN to access funds

Awards

- Up to \$5 million in available funding
- Requests can range from \$25,000 to \$250,000
- All expenditures must be incurred prior to September 30, 2024
- Reimbursements must be requested with appropriate documentation at least every three months via the Department's Comprehensive Continuous Improvement Plan (CCIP)

Eligible Expenses

All federal ARP ESSER grant funds should be used to:

- Address the effects of lost instructional time due to COVID-19
- Meet the wellness and academic needs of students

Procurement with Federal Funds

Making purchases with federal funds should follow your organizations procurement policy.

The policy should outline what your organization considers a micro-purchase and small purchases.

Procurement with Federal Funds

[2 C.F.R. 200.320](#)(a) – *Procurement by a micro-purchase is the acquisition of supplies or services, the aggregate dollar amount does not exceed the micro-purchase threshold. Micro-purchases may be awarded without soliciting competitive quotations if the non-Federal entity considers the price to be reasonable.*

Most establish this threshold at \$10,000.

Procurement with Federal Funds

[2 C.F.R. 200.320\(b\)](#) – *Small purchase procedures are those relatively simple and informal procurement methods for securing services, supplies or other property that do not cost more than the Simplified Acquisition Threshold. If small purchase procedure are used, price or rate quotations must be obtained from an adequate number of qualified sources.*

When exceeding more than \$10k, ensure you are obtaining multiple quotes.

Application Submission and Timeline

- Grant submissions are due on or before 5 p.m. on Friday, September 30, 2022.
- Completed application and required supporting documents are to be submitted to acceleratinglearning@education.ohio.gov.
- Grant award notification timeline
- Grantee webinar and kickoff is expected in the weeks following award announcement.
- Questions may be directed to acceleratinglearning@education.ohio.gov during the application period.

Selection Process

- Technical Review of required components
- Quality Review by two independent reviewers

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be scored on Design Requirements on a rubric as follows:

1	No to little evidence
2	Some evidence; there is some information provided that suggests the application meets this expectation.
3	Convincing evidence; the information provided suggests the application meets this expectation.
4	Strong evidence; the information provided suggests the application has thoroughly met this expectation.

Scoring

Some items in the Application Narrative will be weighted. See below for points available per each section of the application.

Strategy to Accelerate Learning in Literacy	Double-weighted; up to 8 points
Preparing Students for Future Success	Up to 4 points
Needs of the Community	Up to 4 points
Capacity and Readiness of Library System	Up to 4 points
Student Needs	Up to 4 points
Students Served	Unscored
Proposed Outcomes	Double-weighted; up to 8 points
Timeline	Up to 4 points
Budget Request	Unscored
Budget Detail	Up to 4 points
