BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION	Under the supervision of the Adult Services Assistant Manager, coordinates the technology and maker programming for the library. Teaches technology and computer classes to library patrons. Instructs and assists library patrons in using traditional technology services and software. Also, instructs and assists library patrons in the use of makerspace equipment and software such as sound recording gear, 3D printers, vinyl and craft cutters, CNC machines, laser engravers, sewing machines, heat press, etc. Responsible for providing excellent customer service.

Three to five years experience in a library setting. Experience in a makerspace or other creative space, or other relevant experience.
