The ideal candidate will be passionate about providing exceptional library services to children, teens, and their families. This role involves planning and implementing programs, managing the youth collection, and fostering a love of reading and lifelong learning among young patrons.

Position Overview:

- 1. Design, develop, and conduct engaging programs for children, teens, and their caregivers.
- 2. Coordinate and promote special events, summer reading programs, and other activities aimed at youth.
- 3. Collaborate with schools, community organizations, and other partners to deliver effective programs and services.
- 4. Select, order, and maintain a diverse collection of materials for children, including books, audiovisual materials, and digital resources.
- 5. Evaluate and weed the collection regularly to ensure it remains current, relevant, and in good condition.
